### Footway improvement work starting in your area

#### What is happening

We are pleased to inform you that we will be carrying out Footway improvements along Station Road, Goosetry.

#### Why is it happening

Works to deliver footway improvements are scheduled to start on 10 May 2023, and will take 12 days to complete.

#### When it's happening

The works will take approximately 12 days to complete, commencing on 10 May 2023 excluding weekends, bank holidays and polling day:

- A road closure will be in place between the hours of 08:00 – 17:00

Under current Health & Safety legislation and for the safety of our workforce and members of the public, it will be necessary for a road closure to be in place during these works.

We understand there is no right time to undertake this work however, the scheme has been carefully planned to minimise any inconvenience to you and other road users. Please note that we occasionally have to change our works at short notice due to unforeseen circumstances such as adverse weather conditions or logistics.

#### What you can expect

- Signage on street in advance of the work starting
- Our team working on the carriageway
- Machinery and vehicles
- Barrired areas to create safe working zones, in line with current Health & Safety legislation
- 'Business open as usual', 'Road Closed Ahead/Diversion' and 'Cyclist dismount' signs

#### Access to your property or business

We will make every effort to maintain vehicle access to your property or business. However, due to the nature of the works some inconvenience may still occur and there could be times when point of entry will vary. Please note, this letter does not grant you access through the road closure. If you have any specific access requirements, please raise these with our site supervisor as soon as possible.

Your safety and the safety of our workforce is our priority. Our Traffic Management Officers will be supplied with CCTV cameras and they will assist you as the work progresses.
